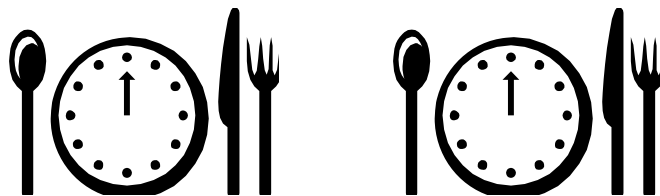




Certified Food Safety Class

Importance of food safety

- 76 million cases of gastrointestinal illness/year
- 325,000 hospitalizations/year
- 5,000 deaths/year
